(1) In 1975, the new State laws for insulation requirements for home construction ended the era of solid adobe wall construction. This home had to be adobe veneer to meet the requirements.

(2) This was my home from 1977 to 1988. Adobe veneered was used in this construction because it was built after insulation laws wouldn't allow solid wall construction

(3) A solid wall post & beam adobe home-- residence of Don and Beth Burton from 1975 until they passed away in 2013. Don Burton started to build his home on Crisie Lane in 1975 so the home missed the new restrictions.
